NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
NOVICE INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12-15 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
NOVICE SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
OPEN JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.
OPEN INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12-15 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.
OPEN SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

REGARDING JUDGE'S USE OF RAMPS: At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Cumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Whippets, Kerry Blue Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Chow Chows, Keeshond and Bulldogs. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. *(In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)*

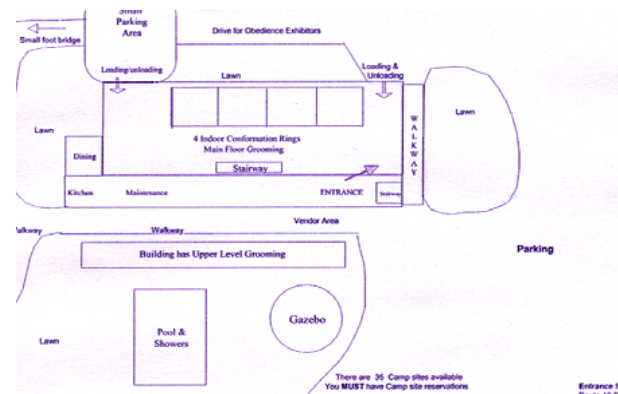
