CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE: An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION: NOTE - Effective January 1, 2005

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: 919-816-3776

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12- 15 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12-15 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Veteran Class - Class for Dogs and Class for Bitches

Best of Breed/Variety Competition

Field Trial or Member Field Trial Class: For dogs/bitches that have earned a placement in a licensed AKC Field Trial during the current year or are Field Trial or Amateur Field Trial Champions.

Hunting Class - For dogs/bitches that have earned an AKC Hunting Dog Title (JH, SH, MH)

Non-Regular Classes

Involving Multiple Dog Entries.

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and 2 of his Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Stud Dog only to be judged on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class: Two Dogs with identical ownership. Brace fee per unit is \$16.00, (dogs must be named at time of entry). If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Only" and the Brace fee per unit is \$21.00.

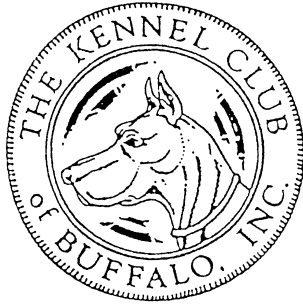

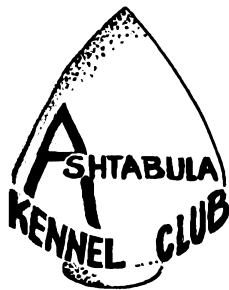
