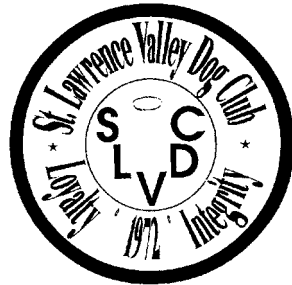

It culminates with separate Bred By Group and Best Bred by Exhibitor in show. Bred By Group judging will follow the Variety Group judging for your Breed in a separate ring. Only dogs entered in the Bred By Exhibitor class are eligible for this competition and must be handled by their breeder/owner.

Spayed and neutered animals may enter this competition.

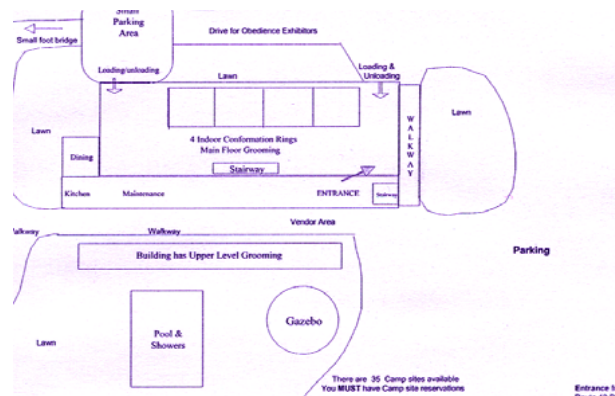
