Best Puppy Competition: All puppies entered in 6-9 or 9-12 puppy classes are automatically in contention for Best Puppy In Show. Puppy class winners in each breed will be judged immediately following Best of Breed to determine Best Puppy. A puppy awarded Best of Breed is automatically Best Puppy. It culminates with separate Puppy Group and Best Puppy in Show. If a puppy places first in the regular Variety Group it is automatically Best Puppy in Group as well. The balance of the Best Puppies in Breed will compete for Group 2nd, 3rd and 4th.
