Hunting Class - For dogs/bitches that have earned an AKC Hunting Dog Title (JH, SH, MH)

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries. (Where Indicated)

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dog and 2 of his Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Stud Dog only to be judged on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered in a regular class.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as above, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class: Two Dogs with identical ownership. Brace fee per unit is \$23.00, (dogs must be named at time of entry). If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Only" and the Brace fee per unit is \$28.00.

REGARDING JUDGE'S USE OF RAMPS: At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Clumber Spaniels, Irish Terriers, Keeshonds, Kerry Blue Terriers, Polish Lowland Sheepdog, Sussex Spaniels, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Whippets, and Xoloitzcuintli. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

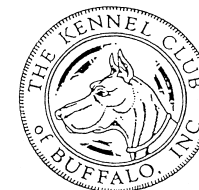

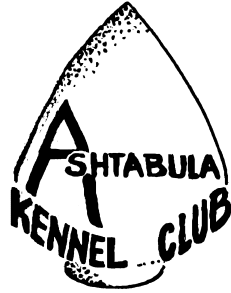
