The Sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs who, on the day of the show, will be six (6) months and under eighteen (18) months of age. The entry fee will be \$10.00 for each dog or bitch. Entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry form as for the Regular Classes, including in the space of Additional Classes the entry for Sweepstakes. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class at the regular fee. All prize money will be paid in the ring to the person handling the dog. No AKC Champions of Record may be shown in the Sweepstakes. Judging will be prior to the Judging of Regular Classes.

#### Sweepstakes Money -

30% of each entry fee will be retained by club. The total of the remaining entry fees will be divided as follows:

First Place in Each Class	25% of the entry fee in that Class

### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION: NOTE - Effective January 1, 2005

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years):** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12- 15 Years):** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years):** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years):** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12-15 Years):** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years):** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, grandmother, including step and half relations. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show card or identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Superintendent's Office. An administrative fee will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. No refunds for duplicate entries. No refunds for Bitches in Season in Obedience Classes.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Due to cost of processing, no refunds \$5.00 and under will be made.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund or entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
