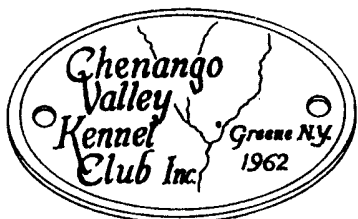

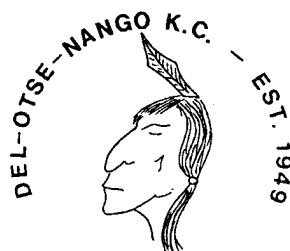

Reduced fees for Puppy and Bred By Exhibitor Classes
(Puppy Classes divided: 6-9 & 9-12 months)

FEES (For ALL Shows in the Leatherstocking Cluster - per day)

CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE: Effective January 1, 2008, the Event Service Fee for all events is to be \$3.00 for the first entry of each dog. Effective January 1, 2008 there will be an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog, as well as the AKC Recording Fee of \$.50. These are included in the entry fee. **RALLY:** An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). These are included in the entry fee.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION: NOTE - Effective January 1, 2005

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE: 919-816-3776

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12- 15 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS (Age 9-12 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTER AGE CLASS (Age 12-15 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS (Age 15-18 Years): For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

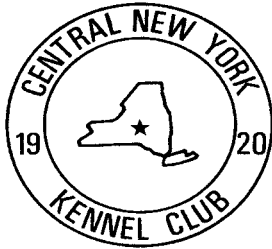

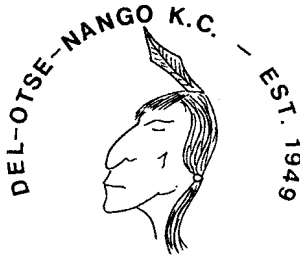
